Tips for Book Sharing

Before Reading

- Make predictions about what will happen.
- Take a "Picture Walk." Look at the pictures and make up your own story.

During Reading

- Ask questions: Who? What? When? Where? Why? How?
- Point out and explain new vocabulary.
- Read with expression.
- Vary your pace.

After Reading

- Relate the story to your child's life or experiences.
- Invite your child to summarize the story.



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10 Reasons to Read Aloud

Sharing books with your child will:

- 1. Provide enjoyment!
- 2. Share special bonding times with your child.
- 3. Develop strong vocabulary and sophisticated language structure.
- 4. Develop imaginative minds!
- 5. Help to nurture healthy brain development.
- 6. Build motivation for and a love of books and reading.
- 7. Increase your child's attention span.
- 8. Introduce genres and writing styles.
- 9. Create rich experiences for children.
- 10. Help second language learners become familiar with the sounds and shapes of English.
